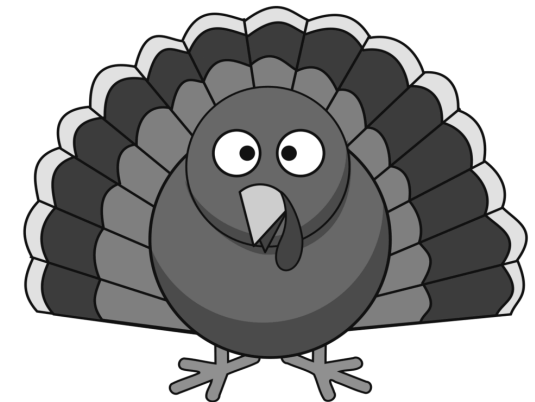

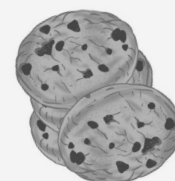
**RMD**

**RENOVATE**

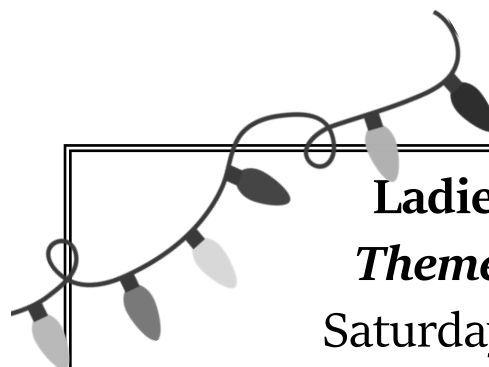
We are bursting at the seams that our building renovation loan is officially paid off thanks to your dedication and sacrificial giving! Thank you! God is faithful!

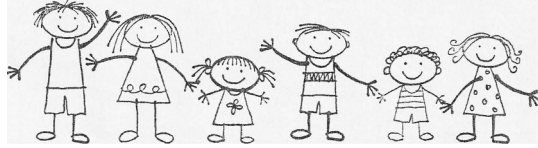

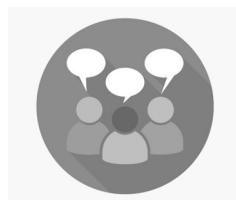


## Coffee Hour Hosts Needed
